

## **JOB ANNOUNCEMENT**

[Florida Memorial University](#) (FMU) invites applications for tenure-track positions at the rank of *Faculty, Assistant Professor in Information Systems* to begin August 2019 and 2020. The position is based in Miami Gardens, FL. Initial screening of applications begins July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 and continues until the position is filled.

A successful candidate will play an active role in FMU's existing academic success. This is a faculty position requiring a strong academic background specifically in Information Systems, Cybersecurity and/or Information Technology, reporting to the department chair of Computer Science, Math & Technology in the School of Arts and Sciences.

The successful candidate will offer both introductory and advanced courses directly related to scheduled instruction, including: lecture, laboratory, clinical, performance and coaching assignments; preparation for instruction; and student assessment activities. Faculty must develop and utilize a course syllabus for each course, following established institutional guidelines. Candidates will also be accountable for collaborative and applied research in various disciplines, including assistance with grant applications and data analysis on funded grants.

### ***Essential Duties***

- Teach information systems, cybersecurity, computer science, and information technology courses;
- Coordinate information systems and/or cybersecurity programs;
- Prepare and coordinate cybersecurity program that can meet one or two industrial (cybersecurity) certifications.
- Perform teaching, scholarship, service and professional development;
- Perform program assessment for accreditation;
- Work collaboratively with the other faculty to advance the programs;
- Actively seek financial support through external research and grants;
- Advise students for both academic and career fields.
- Familiar with Oracle, SAP; SQL; Java; MIS; Systems Analysis; COBIT; managing programs for industrial certification such as CompTIA Security+, Microsoft Security Certification, and CISCO Security Certification.

Ph.D. in related discipline is required at the time of initial appointment. Experience teaching in higher education. Pre-Employment screening is required: criminal background-check and drug-testing.
