- **Federal Pell Grant:** based on remaining lifetime eligibility limits and the number credit hours enrolled.
- **Federal Work-Study:** Must be Pell eligible. Based on the availability of funds and worksites.
- **Federal Direct Student Loans:** If you used your maximum loan eligibility during the FALL and SPRING semesters, you have exhausted your annual maximum loan eligibility. Your parent may apply for the PLUS loan at [www.studentaid.gov](http://www.studentaid.gov) . If your parent was denied a PLUS loan during the academic year, we will determine your remaining UNSUB eligibility, if any.
- **Private student loans:** Offered by private lenders, based on credit worthiness and may require a co-signer.

**Estimated Summer Financial Aid Award Letters will be emailed to the email address we have on file and will be available for pick up in the Office of Financial Aid & Scholarships beginning Wednesday, April 15, 2020. If you apply later, please allow 3 business days before picking up.**

**Summer Financial Aid Regulations:** *please read and initial below to acknowledge understanding of the following:*

**(INITIALS)**

- I understand that eligibility for Summer financial aid is based upon the anticipated number of semester hours I expect to carry for the entire summer as reported on this Summer Application. I understand that most financial aid for Summer Semester requires enrollment in at least 6 hours for undergraduate students. **Student loans require an enrollment of at least 6 hours for undergraduate students.** As an *undergraduate* student, I further understand that I will not receive aid disbursements until I have begun enrollment in classes that brings me to the six-hour credit requirement. \_\_\_\_\_
- I understand that I must notify the Office of Financial Aid & Scholarships of any adjustments to the number of hours for which I am preregistered, and I realize that my original award may be adjusted accordingly. \_\_\_\_\_
- I understand that the Office of Financial Aid reserves the right, on behalf of the University, to review and modify, including cancel, awards at any time because of changes in my academic status, academic program, resident status, enrollment status, etc. I understand that all financial aid awards are contingent upon the availability of funds and my eligibility at the time of disbursement. \_\_\_\_\_
- I understand that if I am disbursed funds for which I am later determined ineligible, I will be required to repay those funds to the University and/or the Department of Education. \_\_\_\_\_
- I understand that my eligibility for Summer financial aid could be affected by Florida Memorial University's Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy. My eligibility for Summer financial aid will be determined after grades are reviewed at the end of Spring Semester for this prior academic year and this application may not be processed until after Spring Semester grades are posted. \_\_\_\_\_
- I understand that I may have used all financial aid eligibility for the 2019-2020 academic year during the Fall and Spring terms and may need to consider pursuing a Private/Alternative loan. My parent may wish to apply for a Parent PLUS loan as well. \_\_\_\_\_
  - If borrowing a Private/Alternative loan, you must allow THIRTY (30) days for the lender to process and request school certification of the loan. \_\_\_\_\_
- **I understand that I am responsible for any balance not covered by financial aid and my balance must be paid to clear the Business Office and avoid being dropped for non-payment.** \_\_\_\_\_

- To receive your award letter before Summer School starts, your request must be received by Friday, May 1, 2020. *The Office of Financial Aid will notify you electronically (via email) when your award letter is available for pick up. You may also view your award information via the Lion's Aid System.*
- The 2019-2020 FAFSA must be on file to determine if you are eligible for financial aid for 2020 summer.
- Students must enroll in at least 6 (six) credit hours to be eligible for loans.** Loan amounts and eligibility will be determined by the Financial Aid Office.
- If you are attending multiple sessions: You must have 6 credit hours in any 1 session before your financial aid will disburse. Students who enroll for 3 credits in session A and 3 credit hours in session B will not have aid disbursed until drop/add has ended for session B.
- If you have used all your federal direct loan eligibility during the 2019-2020 academic year (Fall/Spring), your parent(s) may apply for a parent PLUS loan. If the PLUS was denied during the regular academic year and you have already received the Unsubsidized Loan, you are not eligible for those funds. \*\*Parents may apply for the PLUS by going to [www.studentaid.gov](http://www.studentaid.gov) and log in using their FSA ID Username or email and FSA Password.**
- As another option, you may apply for an alternative student loan to assist you with the cost of summer school. (Must be applied for and approved at least 15 days before Summer begins).
