



Information on the Biology/Pre-nursing Program and Application

Please read before applying to the Biology/Nursing Program

Florida Memorial University **does not** offer a Bachelors degree in Nursing. FMU **does** have a partnership with the University of Miami and Florida International University in nursing. Students that wish to be a part of either partnership program **must apply** for admission. These programs are competitive and students must meet all requirements to be in the program. **International** students who decide to participate in the program will not receive the financial benefits associated with the program at the participating nursing schools, and are responsible for all financial obligations at the partnering institutions. Only five students each semester may transfer based on the established MOAs that exist between FMU and each partnering institution.

These students will be eligible for any financial benefits that are associated with the program. For example, students under this program who transfer to UM often receive a tuition break. Students pay FMU tuition rates instead of the UM tuition rates. Students who transfer under the program do not have to compete with all other transfer students in these nursing programs if they are among the top five in the transfer group from FMU.

Students **cannot declare** themselves Biology/Nursing majors without being accepted officially into the program. We **do not have a nursing major** currently at FMU and therefore students are pre-nursing students at FMU. Students must meet with the Biology/Nursing advisor for advisement or jeopardize their place or acceptance in the program.

To be **eligible immediately** for this program, the student must meet three of the following requirements to apply.

1. High school or transfer GPA of 3.3 or higher.
2. SAT score of 1000 or higher or ACT score of 21 or higher. If the student has not taken either exam, he/she must take the College Placement Test (CPT). The student will not be eligible to apply to the Biology/Pre-nursing program until he/she has completed all remedial classes with a satisfactory grade (A – B).
3. No remedial/developmental courses. This requirement may be waived if grades are a B or higher. If student is a freshman, he/she **cannot apply** to the Biology/Pre-nursing program until after he/she has taken all remedial courses and passed them (**B or higher**).
4. If transferring, the student **cannot apply** if there are multiple repeats of (science and mathematics) classes. If there is only one repeat, it may be waived if it does not count toward the prerequisite classes for the pre-nursing program. Any transfer student accepted into the Biology/Pre-nursing program must maintain the GPA requirement each semester to stay in the program. The GPA requirement is dependent on the nursing school of choice (FIU and UM is cumulative of a 3.5 or higher, 3.3 pre-requisite requirement).
