**Re:** SACSCOC Status Update

FMU's Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) Task Force would like to provide an update regarding our SACSCOC status. As we work to remove FMU's Probation for Good Cause and regain compliance with SACSCOC, we have the following to report:

- The continuing national challenges with COVID-19 impacted the start of the Spring Semester. Additionally, the adjustments also impacted plans to hold conversations regarding the proposed program closures and other employment actions. Therefore, these meetings will be held throughout the month with individuals who may be impacted. The Divisions of Academic Affairs and Human Resources will schedule meetings according to the preliminary schedule below.
  - Week of February 7 Faculty and staff individual meetings regarding salary reduction and position status
  - Week of February 14 Student teach-out notification for program closures
  - o Week of February 21 Individualized Student Academic Plan and Advising
- Program closures have been submitted to SACSCOC for their approval and the University is now allowed to move forward with implementation. Please see the lists of both the discontinued programs and the current programs below.
- The SACSCOC full report will be submitted in March, with a site visit scheduled for April. SACSCOC will render a decision in June.

The Task Force continues to meet weekly to ensure we are addressing the issues critical to maintaining accreditation.
