Re: SACSCOC Makes Final Decision on Florida Memorial University's Probation

Status

The SACSCOC Board of Trustees voted to remove Florida Memorial University's current sanction, Probation for Good Cause.

The final step in the SACSCOC review process took place in Tampa on Tuesday, June 14, during the annual Board of Trustees retreat with the FMU SACSCOC Task Force Team.

This rendered decision was made after the SACSCOC review committee visited the campus in April. During the site visit, committee members reported no findings and concluded that FMU met and fully satisfied all standards.
